Board Approved Dress Code

*The Island City Academy dress code has been established to provide a consistently attractive and neat appearance for all students and to avoid peer pressure in matters of dress. The overwhelming result of the dress code should be a "neat and tidy" appearance.*

Items	Description	Color
Bottoms Dresses/jumpers	Pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, dresses, jumpers, and capris <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Pants must be chino or dress in style, straight leg (no skinny fit, <b><u>leggings, ponte pants, pants with elastic around the ankle, cargo pants, no joggers for boys or jeggings</u></b>) <b><u>Pants cannot have holes or rips in them.</u></b></li> <li>● Capris, shorts may be worn until October 15<sup>th</sup> and after April 15<sup>th</sup></li> <li>● Dresses/skirts must have red, white, or blue shorts under them or leggings when not wearing tights</li> <li>● Dresses/jumpers, shorts, skorts, and skirts must be <u>2" above the knee or less when standing.</u></li> </ul>	Navy Blue Khaki
Belts (Optional)	Belts are only required for Oxford shirts which must be tucked in. Plain with buckle <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Solid color</li> <li>● Cloth</li> <li>● Leather or leather like</li> <li>● Buckle in the front</li> </ul>	Black Brown Navy Blue Khaki
Shirts	Solid color without manufacturer's logo <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Polo Shirt               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Long or short sleeve</li> <li>○ At least 2 buttons</li> <li>○ Not required to be tucked in</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Oxford button down shirts must be tucked in and worn with a belt</li> <li>● Visible undergarments will be white or the same color as dress code shirt</li> </ul>	Red White Navy Blue
Sweaters/Sweatshirts	Solid Color <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Must have a collared shirt underneath</li> <li>● No hoods</li> </ul> *ICA hoodies may be worn on Fridays	Red White Navy Blue
Socks/Leggings/Tights	Solid Color Tights/Leggings <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Must cover feet or be worn with socks</li> </ul> Socks <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <b><u>Must be worn at all times</u></b></li> </ul>	Red White Navy Blue Black

Shoes	<p>Slip-on shoes must fit firmly on the feet  All other shoes/boots must be tied and laced with bows on the outside or Velcro, if no laces  Pants should cover the tops of any high-top shoes/boots  Plain color shoes and laces  ½" heel or less on girl's dress shoes (for safety reasons)  <u><b>No light up shoes or open toed shoes</b></u>  <u><b>Red accents are allowed but must be less than 10% of total shoe color. No other accent colors will be allowed other than colors listed.</b></u></p>	Shoes/Laces <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Navy Blue</li> <li>● Black</li> <li>● White</li> <li>● Gray</li> <li>● Brown</li> </ul>
Hair Style	Hairstyles must be conservative including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● no designs shaved in head</li> <li>● no mohawks</li> <li>● natural hair color</li> </ul>	
Hair Accessories	Hats and winter headgear are to be worn outside as weather requires <u><b>Not Acceptable headwear:</b></u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● <u><b>No ears, unicorn horns or crowns</b></u></li> <li>● <u><b>Size of bow and headband attachments must be 3" or smaller in height and width.</b></u></li> <li>● <u><b>Jojo or similar type bows.</b></u></li> </ul> Acceptable headwear: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Headbands</li> <li>● Barrettes</li> <li>● Ponytail holders</li> </ul>	
Jewelry	Bracelets <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One per arm</li> <li>● 1" thick or less</li> </ul> Rings <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One ring per hand</li> </ul> Necklace <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One necklace allowed</li> </ul> Earrings <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● One post earring per ear (Pre-K – 5<sup>th</sup>)</li> <li>● 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> may wear 1" in length or diameter and maximum of 2 earrings per ear</li> </ul>	Reasonable appearance
Make-up/Body Art	Any tattoos real or fake should be covered at all times 6 <sup>th</sup> – 8 <sup>th</sup> grade girls may wear light natural color make-up- <u><b>Nail polish can be of any color except black</b></u>	

\*Notify the office if an exception to the dress code needs to be made for religious or cultural reasons.

\*The Board designates the on-site Administrator to make all final decisions on the dress code.

Students that come to school out of dress code will not earn their FIRE Letter and will be directed to the office. The student will be provided an opportunity to find dress code attire from the rack in the hallway. If no clothes can be located then the student will be asked to call a parent/guardian to bring the correct dress code attire.
